VISION

To equip and raise up the next generation of kingdom forerunners who know their identity in Christ as a son or daughter of God; who have an intimate relationship with the Father; who live in fellowship with and operate out of the power of the Holy Spirit.

To equip leaders who serve the body of Christ and know how to work as part of an apostolic company, who seek to see the kingdom of God expanded throughout the earth.

MISSION

The mission of The Greenhouse is to equip emerging young leaders who have a call to serve the body of Christ and extend the Kingdom. To explore their God-given purpose and see it defined through the discovery and development of their gifts, call, destiny and purpose.

Through direct, individual and personal mentoring by fivefold ministries, these forerunners will be encouraged to step out of their comfort zone as they serve, learn and grow alongside others. To see individuals spend a year in a thriving community of believers and dive into deeper levels of intimacy with the Father and know who they are in Christ.



PROGRAM SUMMARY

The Greenhouse is a one-year transformational experience designed for the effective equipping of the next generation of leaders for the Kingdom of God.

You will be immersed into one of Australia's most dynamic apostolic communities and have the privilege of engaging at a close and personal level with recognised five-fold leaders within The Way Community.

In this live-in internship and ministry leadership training program, you will dwell together in a communal housing environment (discipleship house) and will engage in various house churches and corporate gatherings. You will contribute into the lifestyle of The Way community as servant leaders.

You will engage in a lifestyle of Christianity which takes salvation, healing, deliverance and miracles as part of the daily life of the believer and pursues a lifestyle of growing in the fruits of the Spirit, character, holiness, power and love.

As part of this apostolic company of believers and as members of The Greenhouse, you will also be heavily involved in evangelism and mission; with several opportunities for national and international missions throughout the year.



Through intensive study of the scripture and other resources, you will be rooted firmly in the doctrines of Christ to be ready to launch into your next season.

This is a live-in discipleship program that requires a high level of commitment to spiritual growth and to the community of believers.

Only those interested in this kind of training should apply and continue with this application.

A UNIQUE AND SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY

The Way Community has a unique spiritual culture. It is one of the most vibrant revivalist communities in the country and has a proven history of rapidly raising up, empowering, equipping and releasing leaders who are going to the nations throughout the world. We have a strong prophetic culture with an emphasis on worship, prayer & encounter. We believe that we offer a transformational and accelerated ministry development opportunity for those who are hungry to prepare themselves to live life devoted to the work of the Kingdom of God.



OUTLINE

LIFESTYLE

You will engage in a 40 week program beginning in February 2020 and concluding in December 2020. You will work enough hours in the week (casual/part-time, approx. 20 hrs a week) to both support yourself and engage purposefully in ministry.

The 40 week program will run alongside school terms to allow you to have holiday breaks to see family, fund raise if necessary and keep to your study schedule (mission trips permitting).

Your weekly routine will include individual and occasional group morning devotional times. Committed engagement with house churches in the community, regular outreach ministry, weekly apostolic teaching day and serving at main meetings.

MENTORING

You will have a mentor assigned to you for weekly one-on-one input from out of the senior leadership of The Way Community.

Mentors will do all they can to encourage each disciple in their growth and fruitfulness. Jesus' way of teaching was highly relational and we recognise that some of the most important qualities are caught rather than taught.



DISCIPLESHIP HOUSE

The purpose of the house is:

- to create an atmosphere where you can focus on your studies and ministry with minimal distractions
- where you can live in a culture of kingdom family and community with discipline and accountability
- contributing to the needs of fellow house mates and the wider community
- to participate in shared devotional & worship/prayer times
- where you will share meals, house chores & responsibilities
- training will also take place around practical things such as caring for the property you inhabit, personal finances coaching, and general household and domestic care

STUDIES

You will engage in extensive studies of the scriptures. You will also be assigned other books for study with assessment of assignments based on the materials you have read. You will participate in a Greenhouse day once a week which will be a full day of all the students, house leaders & Greenhouse leadership team intentionally diving into deeper studies, activation's & training around life in the Kingdom of God.



MINISTRY TRAINING

You will engage in ministry on a range of levels:

- take turns in leading devotional/worship times within the discipleship house
- assist in the leadership of house churches
- as a team, launch an evangelistic outreach with the support of The Way Community
- volunteer in our food bank
- technical, logistical and administrative training for large meetings and church administration
- local missions trip to a closed indigenous community in the Northern Territory or an overseas missions trip to either South America or Uganda
- training from visiting internationally recognised ministries
- deep-dive training and experience in the supernatural and spiritual gifts
- training and experience in leading, worship and preaching



CORE VALUES

INTIMACY WITH THE FATHER

Our first mandate is ministry unto the Father. Everything we do as believers must be grounded out of a deep and intimate relationship with the Father. Just as we saw Jesus model, we also must cultivate a lifestyle of closeness with the Father. If we don't remain in intimacy with the Father, it will compromise our ability to effectively love others.

LOVE

Love has to be the foundation of being a follower of Christ and all that we do. As we pursue the source of love, we are then able to love like He loves. Jesus answered 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbour as yourself. There is no commandment greater than these.' (Mark 12:30–31)



CHRIST IDENTITY

Know who you are in Christ! Jesus is the way, the truth and the life and He is our model for ministry and when we define ourselves by Him, we live fruitful and productive lives. While walking on this earth, He walked closely with a few, modelling and teaching the disciples what it meant to be a follower of Him. We embrace and walk in the identity of our sonship through our divine union with Christ. We emphasise that as Jesus obeyed the will of the Father, as followers of Christ we are commanded to do the same.

GROW IN THE SPIRIT

Sons and daughters are led by the Spirit of God. (Romans 8:14) We are no longer orphans but mature sons and daughters who know our identity in Christ and know how to hear the Spirit of God. Jesus said 'I must go so that another will come'. But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthener, Standby) will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him (the Holy Spirit) to you [to be in close fellowship with you]. (John 16:7). The Holy Spirit is the empowering agent of the Godhead who is on the earth today. Accordingly we emphasise His role and presence in our community through the demonstration of the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit as part of the daily life of the believer. We also look to grow in all of the fruits of the Holy Spirit. (Galatians 5:22)



KINGDOM CARRIERS

Jesus said "The Kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you." (Luke 17:20–21)

We carry the Kingdom of God within us and we are called as kings and priests to reach the world, make disciples, influence culture and inspire true change. We are citizens of the Kingdom of God which is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost. As we see the Kingdom of God expand in the hearts of men, we will see the culture around us be transformed.

PRIESTHOOD OF ALL BELIEVERS

The whole body of Christ is called to do the work of the ministry. To raise up disciples who go onto make disciples. This isn't the job of just the church leadership but is the call for every individual who calls themselves a follower of Christ.

APOSTOLIC COMPANY

We believe that men and women who are called today as apostles and prophets continue to provide the foundational structure of the Church with Christ as the Chief Cornerstone. (Ephesians 2:20) We believe the effective equipping of the body of Christ requires the five-fold gifts. (Ephesians 4:11-13) These five-fold roles operate as coaches for the rest of the body to function at their full potential to do the work of the ministry.



COMMUNITY OF BELIEVERS

In Acts 2:42–47, we read about the vibrant community of believers who the Lord added to their number daily, those who were coming to life.

Some of the vital keys of this community are: apostolic teaching; sharing meals & communion; signs & wonders; sharing possessions; meeting together daily in the courts and meeting together in homes with joy and humility; continuous praises to God and enjoying fellowship with brothers & sisters in Christ.

We believe this scripture provides a template that we actively seek to live by.

WEEKLY COMPONENTS

STUDY

Bible reading and study of assigned books with set assignments will make up a significant part of the weekly study regime. You will read specific portions of the bible to gain a strong grasp of the story and allow a full understanding of the scriptures during the course of the year.

GREENHOUSE DAY

One day a week will be set aside for all Greenhouse participants to come together with leaders for a full day of teaching and activations around our life in Christ and with the Holy Spirit. There will be opportunity for fellowship and ministry on these days also.

MINISTRY

HOUSE CHURCHES

You will be assigned to assist in the leadership of one of the many house churches that make up The Way community. House churches are the primary focus of ministry in The Way.

OUTREACHES

Part of The Greenhouse program will be to launch a completely new outreach ministry from scratch as a team. Time will be devoted each week to this program.



DISCIPLESHIP AND COMMUNITY

DEVOTIONAL

Devotional times among house members in the discipleship house will take place where you will go deeper in the Word, worship, pray, share the Lord's supper and encourage and exhort one another.

ONE-ON-ONE MENTORSHIP

A weekly meeting with a recognised five-fold ministry or senior leader from The Way for personal input, development, counselling and training.



MONTHLY COMPONENTS

WITHOUT WALLS

The first Saturday of every month is devoted to Without Walls – a gathering that is open to all believers across the region to come together for an extended time of worship, encounter and teaching. The purpose of this gathering is to provide an open forum for the expression and ministry of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, where the body of Christ ministers one to another through spiritual gifts. You will be involved in serving that meeting at all levels from logistical aspects of setting up and packing down, technical aspects such as audio and video, to leadership functions such as leading the meeting, worship or speaking.

THE WAY GATHERING

The third weekend of every month is another gathering similar to Without Walls but is devoted solely to those who are part of The Way Community.

LEADERS MEETINGS

All participants in The Greenhouse program will be considered part of the wider leadership team of The Way and thus will be involved in leaders meetings.



OTHER COMPONENTS

Throughout the course of the year there will be other opportunities for powerful and significant input from key leaders and visiting ministries through ministry intensives and exclusive training times. See the section on visiting ministries to get an indication of who you will be receiving input from. All conferences and intensives are free for members of The Greenhouse.

THE PEACE COLLABORATION

The Peace Collaboration is a high energy, intentional evangelism and church planting initiative that is unique to The Way. You will be engaged in prayer, gathering prophetic intelligence and outreach into communities with evangelism and crusade ministry. Along with following up and training new disciples as we intentionally plant new churches in suburbs within Bendigo as well as towns surrounding Bendigo.

EXCLUSIVE INTENSIVES

All visiting ministries will be providing exclusive intensive training sessions with our Greenhouse members. This will give you opportunity to spend time with these key people in a small group setting and receive ministry and input.

MISSION TRIPS

All members will do at least one missions trip during their time at The Greenhouse. It can either be a trip to our indigenous community mission in Ali Currung, NT or one of the international trips to either South America or Uganda.

These are a great opportunity to expand your horizons, serve others and increase the Kingdom of God.

These trips are self-funded by members and will vary in expense and experience.

South America – crusade ministry in Argentina and Peru. This trip will be a high energy, high demand trip that will carry an expectation for engagement in power ministry for 2 weeks.

Uganda – conference ministry in Kampala, Uganda followed by outreach ministry into rural towns and villages. This trip will be a high energy, high demand trip that will carry an expectation for engagement in power ministry.

Ali Currung, NT – working with our local missionaries doing outreach, feeding programs, teaching small groups and learning cross-cultural engagement.



SUPPORT STRUCTURES

Aside from the deep community that The Way is known for, there are a range of support facilities that are in place to ensure the success of all participants in The Greenhouse:

FOOD

The Way Community has a Food Bank. There is an open-door policy to members of The Greenhouse to draw upon the resources of the Food Bank if necessary.

PASTORAL CARE

The pastors and pastoral team of The Way Community are there to provide support for The Greenhouse members.

FINANCIAL COUNSELLING

The Way Community has a financial counsellor who can assist members of The Greenhouse with budgeting and financial stewardship.

HOUSE LEADER

The discipleship house is facilitated by an experienced young leader, who is a long-standing member of The Way Community. They are available to provide support or referral as appropriate and to establish the culture of the home.
